

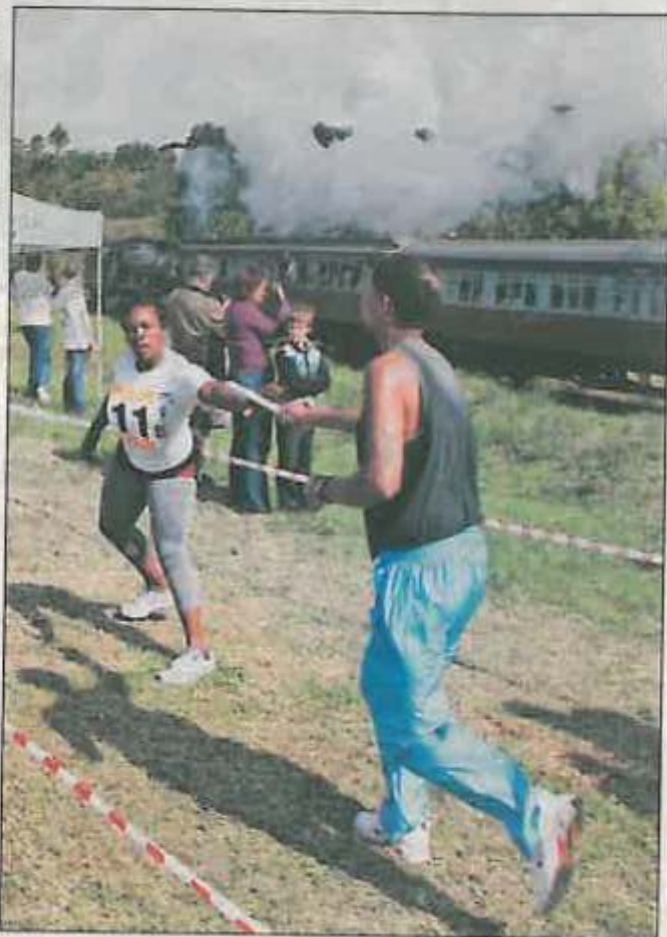
# Train race tests man vs machine
